



Green Valley Cemetery - Rules & Regulations

Lots in the cemetery are conveyed for memorialization purposes only and are subject to such rules and regulations as are now or shall hereafter be amended by Green Valley Cemetery.

No interments, inurnments, or entombments will be allowed in the cemetery without a permit for disposition issued by the State of California. Interment orders must be signed by the legally responsible party before graves are opened.

An outer burial container approved by Green Valley Cemetery must be used in every grave that is to be used for the burial of human or cremated remains. Containers for cremated remains must be approved by the cemetery authority.

Green Valley Cemetery reserves the right to exclude from any lot, any headstone, monument or other structure; trees, plastic or real flowers, plants or other objects, which may conflict with the regulations, or which may be considered injurious to the general appearance of the grounds, lawns, or plots. All markers, monuments, or memorials shall be set without concrete borders. No curbing or masonry of any description shall be placed or installed, nor shall any trees, shrubs, or flowers of any kind be planted on any of the property herein granted, except by written consent of Green Valley Cemetery, which consent is hereby reserved. Bronze markers may require the purchase of granite bases. Vases shall be set directly in the marker, monument, or memorial, or in an approved granite base. A permanent marker (granite, bronze, or marble) must be placed on every plot within eight months of interment. All markers, stones, monuments, and memorials must be approved by the cemetery manager. Marker deposits & setting fees are specified on the General Price List. Markers purchased from outside vendors must be installed by persons or entities who are bonded and insured to perform such work. Green Valley Mortuary & Cemetery does not install products provided by outside vendors and does not warrant product or assume liability for the performance of work associated with such.

No person or persons not employed by the cemetery shall excavate any earth, lay or remove any sod, or alter the grade of any lot within the cemetery, or plant, remove, or trim any tree or shrub.

Interments, inurnments, or entombments made on Saturdays or National Holidays are subject to extra charges. The above mentioned services are not available on Sundays.

No transfer of property in said cemetery shall be legal unless made in the office of and signed by the owner or manager of the cemetery.

Cemetery plot must be paid for in full before any marker or memorial setting may take place. In the event that payments fall six (6) months delinquent, it is agreed that Green Valley may revoke the right of interment in the property described and retain all payments heretofore made as liquidated damages. If in the future, the purchaser(s) purchases the right of interment(s) in any other property directly from Green Valley, within five years from default, at the then prevailing price and terms of payment, they shall receive credit on the new purchase for all sums paid prior to default.

To maintain the dignity of the cemetery, commemorative items, balloons, pinwheels, glass items, votive lights, statues, and shepherd's hooks among other items, are not allowed. **All flowers, real or imitation, or objects other than approved markers, monuments, or memorials, may be permanently removed and discarded on a weekly basis.**

Forty-eight hour notice is required for all interment services.

The undersigned acknowledges receipt of the *Cemetery Rules & Regulations* and agrees to abide by said conditions and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the cemetery, mortuary, its agents, and employees from any damage to grave markers or monuments such as chips or scratches associated with the "normal" maintenance of the cemetery including mowing, trimming, interment, and disinterment of this or any other grave. This does not include damage that interferes with the inscription of the marker or monument.
