



## Daniel C. King

May 14, 1940 - July 22, 2018

Daniel C. King, age 78, of Folsom, California, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by his family on July 22, 2018.

He was born on May 14, 1940 on the family farm in Waynesburg, Pennsylvania, the son of the late Wilbur W. King and the late Margaret Ullom King. The family moved to San Leandro, California when he was 11 years old.

Dan attended Thomas Jefferson Elementary and Bancroft Junior High School. He graduated from San Leandro High School, Class of June, 1958. In 1959, he married his high school sweetheart, Sandra Pierce, and they raised two daughters. Dan battled Lewy Body Dementia for over ten years. He fought his disease bravely and never lost his personality or sense of humor. His greatest joys in life were his family and his close friends. He will be greatly missed by all of the lives he touched during his lifetime.

He never forgot his Pennsylvania "farm boy" roots and loved telling stories of growing up on the family farm. For his final journey, he was laid to rest in Waynesburg, Pennsylvania next to his parents and grandparents. Burial and interment were private.

He is survived by his wife, Sandra King, daughter Lisette Davis and son-in-law Brian Davis, daughter Cristi Jones, grandsons: Taylor Jones, Daniel Jones and wife Arianna and great-granddaughter Aeyvn, Kevin Jones and wife Tyas. Also surviving is his sister, Nancy Lee King Wilson.
